WE DEMAND A PROGRESSIVE DEAL

The result of the referendum was not a mandate to undermine our human rights or our rights at work, to scrap environmental protections or to attack migrants.

We will not allow this government to pursue a race to the bottom in which we all lose. Spread the word about the Progressive Deal – go to www.anothereurope.org to read it in full and write to your MP to ask for their support.

1. Rights at work

We want a deal that preserves EU workers' rights, levelling up not levelling down. These include the 48 working week; four weeks of holiday per year; strengthened equal pay legislation; guaranteed breaks; maternity and paternity pay rights; and protections for agency and temporary workers.

2. Environmental protections

We are fighting for a deal that enshrines equivalent or better environmental protections in British law and commits Britain to fighting global warming.

3. Freedom to move

However much politicians try to blame

migrants for their own failure to provide stable employment and affordable housing, immigration makes a massive net contribution to the UK. We want a deal that defends and extends free movement.

4. Human rights

Theresa May wants to pull us out of the European Convention on Human Rights, which covers the right to a fair trial, freedom of expression and association, and freedom from torture and religious oppression. We need a deal that commits Britain to continued membership.

5. Education and innovation

Sharing and innovating is central to saving lives and advancing humanity's understanding of the world. We want a deal that preserves Britain's membership of Erasmus and other study abroad schemes, and maintains research and collaboration.

6. Science and research funding

British universities are more dependent than ever on EU funds to produce vital research. We want a deal that maintains Britain's access and contributions to EU-wide science and research funding programmes.
